### **Accommodations**

For accommodations, there are some suggestions on the SUCI website. I'll be staying at the Coach House Inn (mentioned on the SUCI website). I found it fastest to just call them at 1-519-596-2361.

I don't know if they have room but contact Nora Mark to see if there is room at the cottage she is staying at. You can email her at [diverlady2002@gmail.com](mailto:diverlady2002@gmail.com). I believe they have the cottage for Sunday night as well. So if you don't have to be back to Toronto for Monday morning, you might want to stay at the cottage and return Monday morning. Nora can confirm all this.

### **The Dives**

We are planning for 3 dives on Saturday and 2 dives on Sunday. So please bring 3 tanks. There is also a chance for a shore dive Friday evening.

For the shore dive Friday, let's meet at the cottage. The address for the cottage is 6360 Highway 6, Tobermory, ON, Canada. When you are coming up highway 6 the driveway to the cottage will be on your right. There is a little mile mark sign with 6360 on it but it is easy to miss. If you see the sign for Cypress Lake Road then you just missed the cottage.

Anyone interested in a shore dive on Friday evening let me know. When everyone who is interested in a Friday dive shows up, we'll plan the dive. I only know two places to shore dive in Tobermory and one is closed. So I'll depend on the group to suggest other possible places to dive on a Friday.

### **Amazing Dive Plan**

Mike McCabe was the divemaster for last year. He put together a great dive plan. I've attached Mike's dive plan from last year. The people diving is different but everything else in his dive plan is good information for this year as well.

### **Tags and Waivers**

Fathom Five is a national marine park. You MUST have a tag to be able to dive there. The SUCI website for Tobermory has links for where to get the tags. Last time I was in Tobermory, you could also buy tags from Divers Den (where we will get tank fills). You can email or call Divers Den. You can get contact information for them at <https://www.diversden.ca/resources.html>.

The website noted above is also where you can get a waiver for Divers Den. You must fill out this waiver in order to be able to dive. Go to <https://www.diversden.ca/images/PDF/InformationSheetPrivateCharters.pdf>. This PDF has information about private charters (what we are). There is a link to a smart waiver. Click this link and you can fill out and sign the waiver online. You can do this at any time. So please do it before the dive weekend.

The resources page also has a link to the Tags form. You can get it at <https://www.diversden.ca/images/PDF/FathomFiveParkTagForm.pdf>. Fill this out and bring it with you. You can pay for 1 day, 2 day or annual tag. If you are diving Friday, get an annual tag. I believe the price of an annual tag is the same as a 1 day and 2 day tag. So you might as well get an annual tag.

### **Tank fills**

We can get our tanks filled at Divers Den. The boat leaves at 8:30am. I believe Divers Den opens at 7:30am. If you dive Friday night and need a tank fill, They stay open until 8pm. You can then pick them up Saturday morning. After our dive on Saturday, you can get your tanks fill Saturday evening and pick them up Sunday morning. The boat is a short walk from the shop. However, they can be very busy in the morning. So don't show up at the shop at 8:25am and expect to grab your tanks and walk to the boat. You might have to wait.

If you are diving nitrox, bring your card. No card, no nitrox fill. If you bring a tank with a little nitrox in it and ask for an air fill, they might still want to see a nitrox card.

### **Extra stuff**

We are going to be out on the boat all day. Bring a hat, bring a jacket or hoodie (you might get a chill; toby is cold). Like all boat dives, bring everything you need, including lunch, because they won't be going back to shore.
